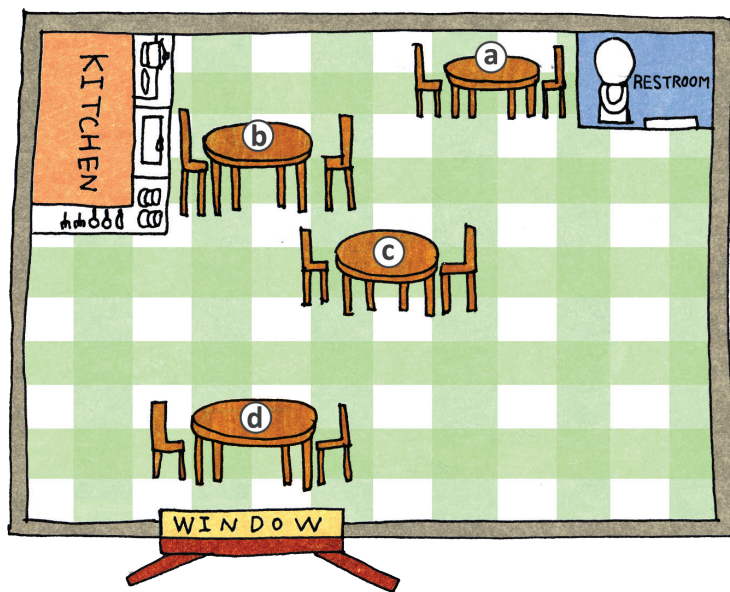

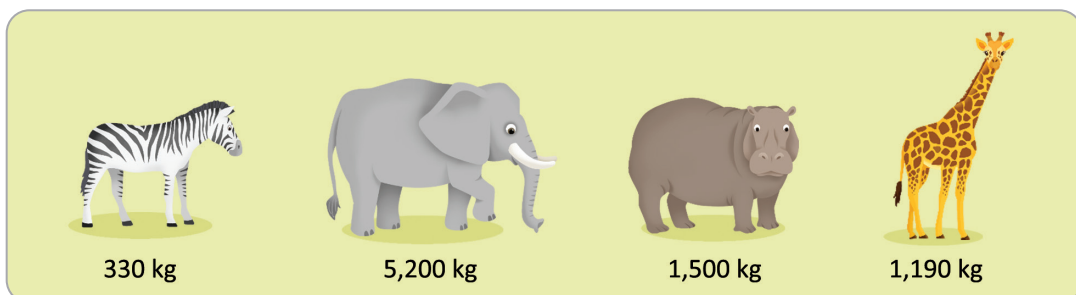

Campers need fire for light, warmth, and cooking. But things sometimes go wrong. Let's say you have a pile of dry tinder and wood ready. What if all your matches are wet? And your lighter is empty? There are other ways of starting a fire. A simple way is with steel and flint.

First, always bring a knife on any camping trip. Your knife is the steel. Next, look for flint, which is a very hard kind of rock. Flint rocks are common by rivers. They're heavy and shiny. Find one with a sharp edge.

Next, hold the flint and your knife over the tinder. Scrape the flint edge quickly with your knife. Why does this work? Steel is mostly iron. The hard flint causes little pieces of iron to break off. The oxygen in the air makes these little pieces catch fire. Those are sparks. They will get your fire started.

Of course, matches and lighters make things easier. But for campers, knowing how to make fire without them is very important. In an emergency, it could even save your life.
